

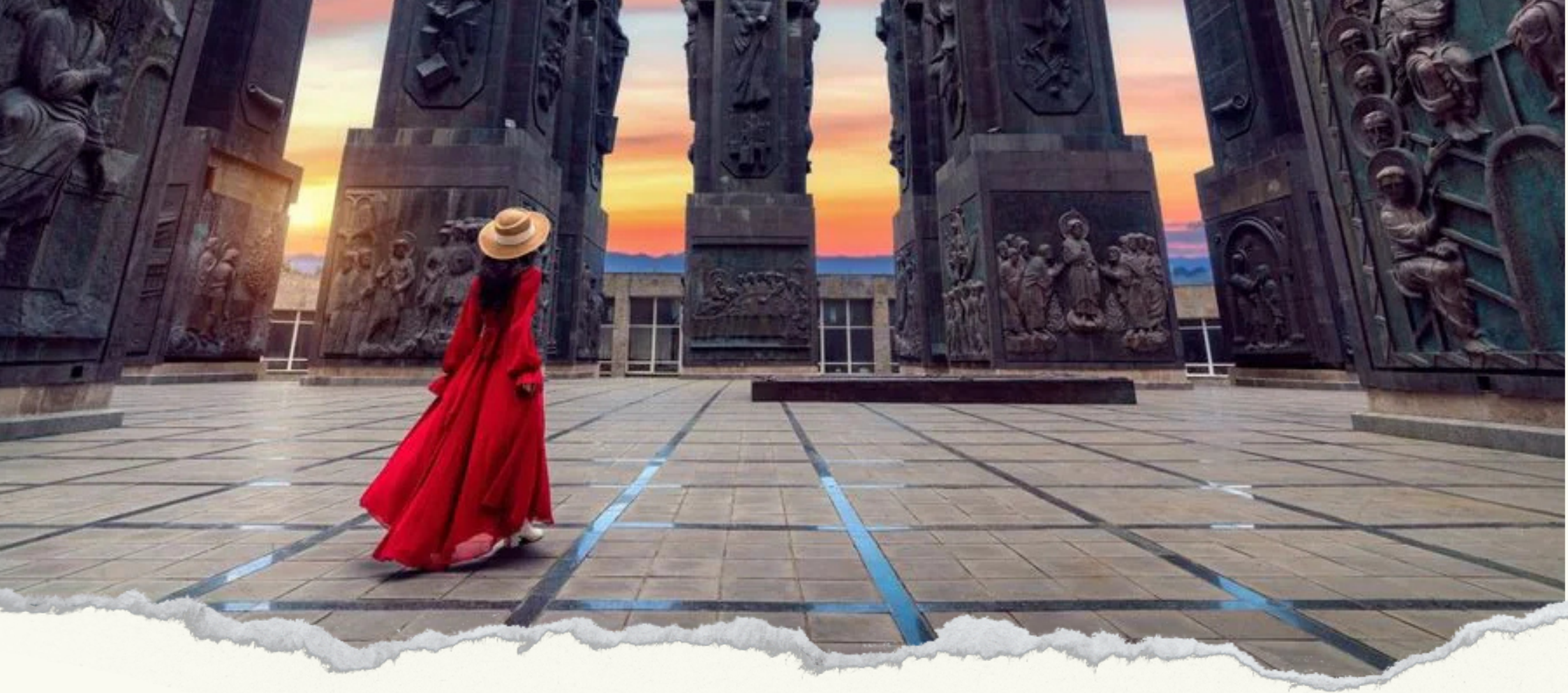

Stop at the iconic Friendship Monument offering spectacular panoramic views of the Caucasus mountains.

Kazbegi & Gergeti Trinity Church

Drive toward Kazbegi and visit the famous Gergeti Trinity Church located at an altitude of 2,170 meters with breathtaking views of Mount Kazbek.

Visit the iconic monument overlooking the city, known for its massive pillars depicting Georgian history.
